We recommend that Messrs Sloan and Thallon and Co. back be granted licenses to lay sewer pipes in the City but that such licenses be granted subject to cancellation without notice.

Respecting the application of the Trustees of lots 1 to 7 and 27 to 35 in Block 6 of District Lot 185 to have the lane between said lots closed, the City Solicitor advises us that it is within the power of the Council to close same but that the Corporation will be liable for any injury done to individuals who have already purchased lands in that vicinity through the closing of said lanes.

The By-law closing it should convey it to the Trustees in trust for educational purposes with a clause that it shall revert to the City if the lots

above mentioned or any of them are at any time hereafter used for any other than educational objects.

In regard to the application of Mr Gideon Robertson to move his building from lot 8 Block 3, Abbott Street to lot on Bordeaux Street we recommend that the application together with all correspondence be referred to Council for its decision thereon.

We recommend that tenders be called for the grading of Dupont Street from Chestnut Avenue to Carl Avenue, and the sidewalking of said street to Dunbar Avenue, also for the grading of a portion of Alexander Street and Heasley Av.

Regarding the application of Messrs McKennan and McGeely for permission to construct a glass and wood structure in rear of their building on Bordeaux Street, we feel that we cannot recommend the granting of their prayer in the face of the present By-Law.

We recommend that a foot path be constructed in a direct line from Suple Jack's grave to the bluff on the Park Road at a cost of about \$2200.

Messrs Gardner and Hermon having offered to establish the street corners in the old Gramville Louisiana for \$1000, we recommend that their offer be
