Your Committee met the Directors of the Vancouver Water Works Co. on Thursday August 29<sup>th</sup> 1889. for the purpose of making arrangements regarding the rates to be charged for water other than for fire purposes and other matters connected with the City's Water Supply.

The Directors stated they could not see their way clear to make the price of water less than 60 cents per thousand gallons as the revenue from all sources barely paid 4 per cent on their outlay.

The Company would like additional expenditure in connection with their System and before doing so wish to know the intentions of the City regarding its purchase.

They also wish the City to enter into an agreement at once for the use of the hydrants as they are now prepared to give all the pressure required for fire purposes. All of which is respectfully submitted. We beg to submit agreement between the Vancouver Electric Illuminating Co and the City for Street Lighting for adoption by Council.
