 sent Westminster Avenue Bridge across  
 Fall Creek, twelve feet on the West Side  
 under the Supervision of the City Engineer

 the Railway Co. and the Railway Company  
 the other half. The addition so constructed  
 to be devoted exclusively to the use of the

 for the public, and that the Agreement  
 with the St. Ry Co be amended accordingly  
 by the City Solicitor, and reported to this Council  
 subject to the Charter.
