A Special Meeting of the Council, called to receive the Draft of the Agreement of the Coquitlam Water Works Company and to consider a grant to be given to L. Dammels and M. Picken for copies of the West Shore and Hand Book, was held on Friday, April 15th 1887, at 4 P.M.

Moved by Alderman Munroe seconded by Alderman Clark,

That Communications be referred to a Committee of three to consist of Alderman Lefevre, Hamilton, and Munroe to report to next meeting of Council.

Coquitlam Water Works

158 The Agreement of the Coquitlam Water Works Company was submitted and read.

Moved by Alderman Hamilton seconded by Alderman Lefevre.

That the draft form of Agreement now submitted be referred to the City Solicitor and the Committee appointed by Council to confer with the Coquitlam Water Works Co. to revise the same and report to Council as soon as complete and that the City Solicitor be

empowered to employ further legal assistance.

Carried.

Moved by Alderman Hamilton
seconded by Alderman Manning,

That the data placed in the hands of the Council by the Logansport Company be sent to H. Schussler & Co of San Francisco and that he be asked whether he will furnish the City a report on the nature and durability of the material proposed to be used; whether the figures are adequate to give the sum specified an estimate of the cost of construction, naming the earliest date his report could be given and his charge for making the same and that he be requested to reply by word as to whether he will give a report.

Carried.
