

- 7 That the following orders be issued:
 - (a) Grading Pender St. from Abbott St. to Railway track. The expense to be taken from the Box drain on Pender St. in hand.
 - (b) Grading Harris St. from Gore to the Carl W.
 - (c) Grading 11th Av from Dubec to Westmount St.

8 That Sufferin Street Bridge be covered 20ft wide instead of 16ft according to recommendations of the City Engineer.

9 That the City Engineer be instructed to notify the Contractors on the back end Paris to push their Contract to completion immediately otherwise the City will have to put on men to do the work at their expense.

10 A communication was received from A. St. G. Hamishy, Secy of Brockton Athletic Club informing the Committee that certain differences had arisen between the Contractor and Engineer representing the City and the Club as to whether the Contract had been completed or not and that it was agreed in order to settle all disputes that if there were over \$800 due the Contractor, the City should retain \$400 for completion of Contract and balances should be paid to the Contractor. If less than \$800 is due then the City shall retain half the amount due for completion and the balance be paid to the Contractor.

The above agreement was made subject to the approval of the Board of Health. The Club wished the sanction of the Board to lay down 50 square yards about the

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Centre of the eastern portion of the grounds for a Cricket pitch, and on the West end, a Lacrosse Ground.

They had engaged the services of Mr. Eldon, an experienced gardener to supervise and carry out the work, and for some doing it by day labor on the advice of the Engineer, as from the nature of the work it cannot be carried out satisfactorily by contract.

The remainder of the grounds to be seeded down and made level.

The Secretary requested the Board to sanction the expenditure and allow the work to be proceeded with and all payments made on joint Certificates from the City Engineer and the Engineer appointed by the Club.

It was resolved that the request of the Club be granted, and that all payments be made as suggested.

11 That the City Engineer be instructed to examine and report upon the petition of John Williams for the construction of a box drain in the gully between Seaton and Furlough Streets.

12 The petition from J. Rebit et al asking to have Bower St graded full width was laid over.
