Court of Revision.

The Council met on Tuesday March 15th 1887 at 10. A. M. His Worship Mayor Macdonald (presiding).

Moved by Alderman Hamilton seconded by Alderman Clark,

That this Council do now form themselves into a Court of Revision for the purposes of revising the Assessment-Rolls, said Court to be composed of the Mayor and full Board of Aldermen the Mayor to be Chairman of the Court. Carried.

Appeals

1. From Carl Strans claiming that he was assessed for 150 acres in District Lots 196 and 181 at \$550⁰⁰ per acre which he appealed against as being too high and also that the land in question ~~did~~ not contain 150 acres.

The acreage was reduced to 127 acres and the Assessment reduced on 80 acres in 181 to \$300⁰⁰ per acre and 47 acres in 196 allowed to remain at old figures.

2. Appeal from Hastings Mill Co on the ground that they were assessed for 20 acres, whereas they did not own that amount. The appeal was considered but no decision arrived at.

The Court adjourned til Wednesday March 16th at 10. A. M.

The Court resumed business on Wednesday March 16th at 10. A. M.

The appeal of the Hastings Mill Co was again taken up.

The acreage was reduced to 20 acres of which the Mill Co are assessed for $15\frac{88}{100}$ acres and the C.P.R. Company $4\frac{12}{100}$ acres.

From Mr. Brady claiming that his personal property assessment of $\$2000.00$ was too high, Assessment reduced to $\$1000.00$

From J. J. Black claiming that the assessment of $\$2150.00$ on lot 17 Block 33, 541 was too high.

Assessment reduced to $\$1350.00$.

From Jas. M. Fox claiming that he was not assessed for lot 12 Block 2, 196 and asking that his assessment be paid. Assessment paid $\$25.00$ and name allowed on the roll as owner of lot 12, Block, 23

From Henry Mutrie appealing against Assessment on lots 9, 10 and 11 Block 2 which he considered too high.

Assessment reduced to $\$300.00$

C.P.R. Company appealed against the assessment of lots 1 to 6 in Block 45, 196 & 181 on the ground that they were set apart for hospital purposes.

Lands exempted from taxation.

From C.P.R. appealing against Assessment of lot 11 Block 2, 196

Assessment reduced to $\$300.00$

C.P.R. lot 17 Block 29, 541 reduced from $\$2500$ to $\$425$.

And Lot 15, Block 29, reduced to \$4.25

A number of changes of ownerships
were made on appeal
