Vancouver June 30th 1886

A Special Meeting of the Council was held on Monday June 30th 1886 at 3 o'clock P.M.

Present His Worship the Mayor, Aldermen Balfour, Dunn, Griffith, Hemlow, L.A. and E.P. Hamilton.

Moved by Alderman L.A. Hamilton seconded by Alderman Balfour that the Report of the City Engineer giving the Special rate to be struck on Water Street be adopted. Carried.

The Council then adjourned.
