The Council met on Tuesday September 9<sup>th</sup> 1890

be appointed chairman. Carried.

x Moved by Alderman Dentell  
Seconded by " Costello

That the Council go into  
Committee of the Whole on the By-Law, govern-  
ing and regulating the Market House and place.  
Carried.

x Moved by Alderman Garden  
Seconded by " Costello.

That the Market By-Law  
be read a second time. Carried.

Alderman Dentell was appointed chairman  
of the Committee of the Whole.

Forty clauses of the By-Law were read in Com-  
mittee after which it rose and asked leave to  
sit again.

The Chairman resumed the Chair after which  
the Council adjourned to meet again on  
Wednesday Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> at 4 P. M.
